- IL Dept. of Labor is requiring the Townships to complete a form itemizing Prevailing Wage work, contract costs etc. The notice was dated May 9 and is due May 13.
- The Supervisor received a notice from Grundy County documenting approval of the proposed levy for the Township for \$47,500, the Road District for \$358,401 and the requested GA amount.

Road Commissioner's Report

- Com Ed tree trimming is in progress.
- Arborist ash tree survey is about half complete; about 200 ash trees have been marked. Some (about 10) trees on W. Southmor Rd. have been marked with an X for removal because they are likely to fall down.
- During heavy rains this week there was 21/2 feet of water on W.
 Southmor Rd. A grating was cleaned which corrected the problem.
- All trucks have been serviced.
- Employee Rodney Jones is back to work with his doctor's approval.
 Mowing will start soon.
- The address Comcast had for the Township has been corrected.
- The new website is being developed. A meeting will be held in the near future to finalize the design and content.
- The budget if being developed.
- The hot mix contract has been awarded to Gallagher at \$44/yd.
- The landscaper was instructed to do no work on the north side of the old Township building.
- IPWMAN Board members will get a credit toward the dues. This will result in a small savings for the Township.

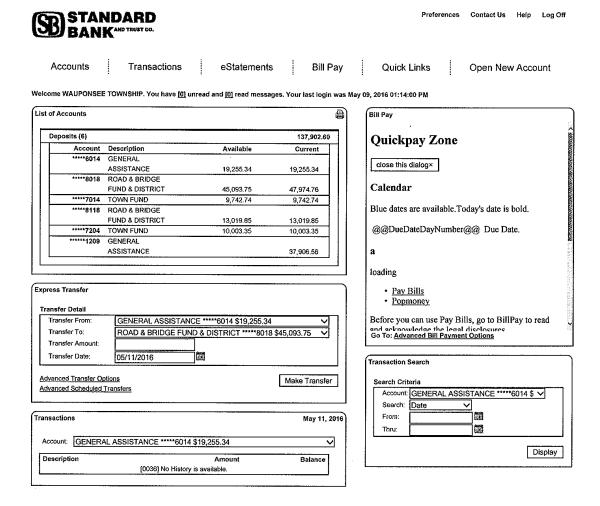
